Columbus, Vera & Morris Jones Memorial Scholarship

For high school seniors at Washington County High School, Washington, KS

Criteria:

- Applicant must be eligible for graduation from Washington County High School, Washington, KS.
- Applicants must be hard-working students but may not be at or near the top of their class. Applicants must be graduating with a minimum of a 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale, and the recipient must maintain that GPA through his or her first semester of the freshman year of college in order to receive the award.
- In cases of equal merit, preference will go to students who plan to attend Kansas State University.
- In cases of equal merit amount students attending Kansas State University, the award will go to the student with the greatest financial need.
- Applications are due by March 31 and should be sent to the Washington County High School Counselor.
